Resolution Supporting Censure of Republican House Members who Voted against the Republican Nominee for Speaker of the House

Whereas, the Plank 213 of the 2024 Platform of the Republican Party of Texas states that all Republican House members shall vote for the Party's Nominee for Speaker, and

Whereas, some Republican Representatives voted for another Nominee in the election of Speaker for the House of Representatives, and

Whereas, the flagrant disregard for Texas Republican Party rules by the aforementioned State Representatives is harmful to the Party and its priorities,

Therefore, Let it be Resolved, that the Calhoun County Republican Party Executive Committee demands the SREC of the Texas Republican Party undertake to censure all members of the Republican Party of Texas who did not vote for the Party Nominee on the first ballot of the Election for Texas House Speaker in the 2025-2026 Legislative Session.

Let it also be Resolved that the Calhoun County Executive Committee of the Republican Party requests that any SREC meetings and votes taken in this matter be transparent and accessible to the Republican Party membership.
